- **Capacity to triple container volumes**

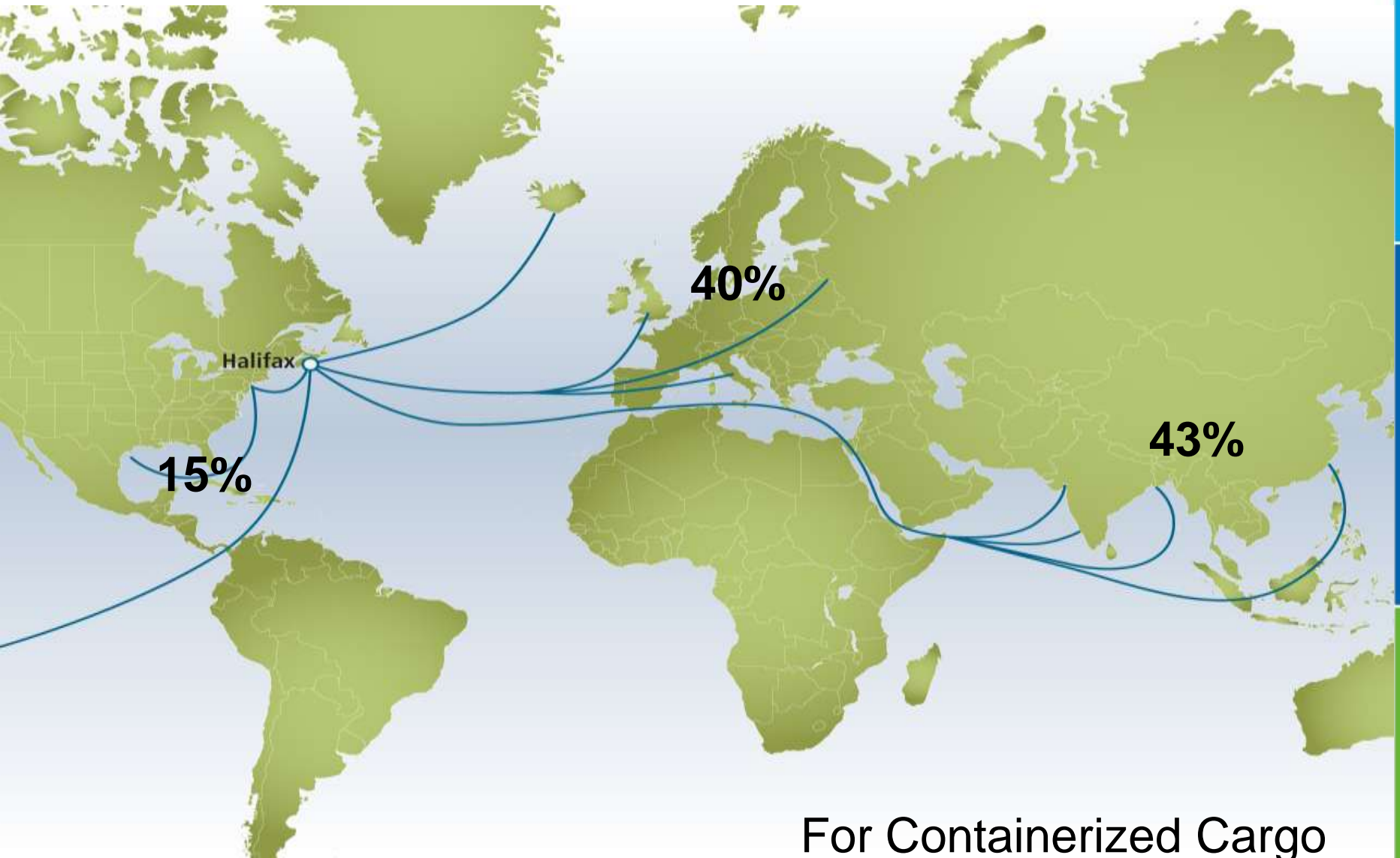
16 Shipping Lines connect our customers to 150 countries

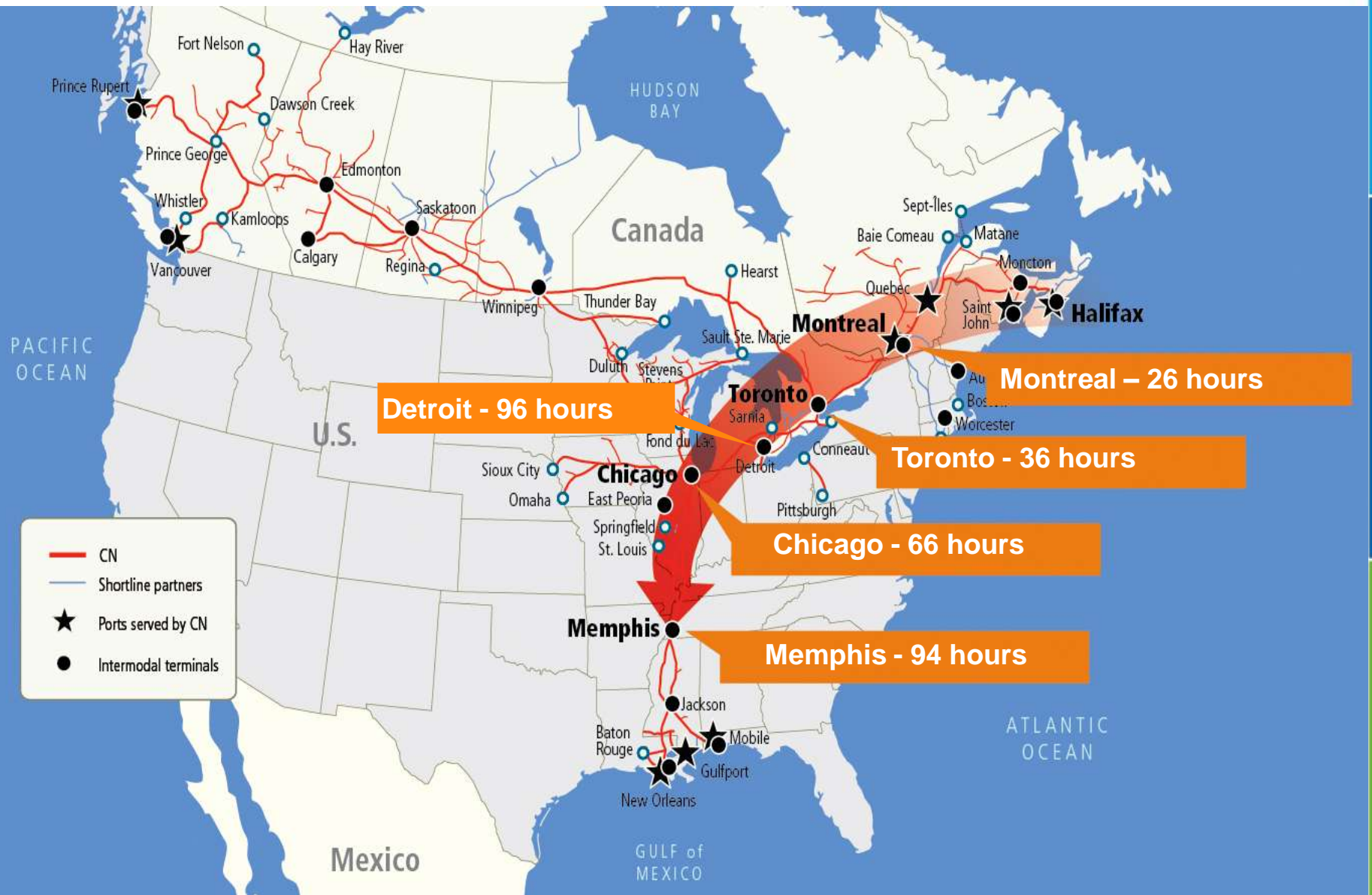
